Job Title: Teacher

- To regularly assess and review individual pupils' progress and achievement and to communicate effectively with parents and carers in line with Houstone procedures and values
- To develop and maintain a learning environment in line with Houstone values
- □ Where appropriate, to mentor staff new to teaching, staff undertaking teacher training programmes and other staff
- □ To actively contribute to enrichment programmes
